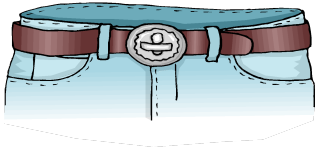
Shirts

- Collared shirts or button down shirts only
- Any Congress Middle School Shirt Club/Team



Shoes

- No heels higher than 1 inch
- Close Toe & Must have a back
- No Slippers
- No Crocs or rubber shoes



Pants

- Jeans (No rips or tears in any part of the jean).
- Pants, skirt, shorts, skorts and capris may be worn- No Holes or rips
- NO TIGHTS or YOGA or Spandex
- Undergarments shall not be visible
- Shorts and skirts must extend to the knee



Headgear & Jackets with Hoods

- No headgear is permitted (e.g., caps, hats, scarves, do-rags, bandanas, night caps, shower caps, hoods, etc.)
- No hooded jackets are allowed to be worn on the person while on school property.

Students must be in full dress code throughout the school day. Having an item with you but not worn appropriately is a violation of the Congress Middle School Dress Code policy. Cold weather exceptions will be announced by administration, as needed. All layers must be compatible with the dress code policy.

School Badges: Identification is required to be on the student at all times. Students will not be allowed to attend afterschool events without their identification. Students will not be allowed on Field Trips without their school ID.
